



ADMISSION TO B.P.Ed.-1

(Recognised by the National Council for
Teacher Education)

1. Duration of Course Two Years
2. Total Seats Available 50 (20 seats are reserved for girls.)
3. Application for admission to B.P.Ed.-1 classes for Academic Session 2018-19 can be submitted ONLINE or OFFLINE.

Online Submission : Online Application Form for admission is available on our college website : www.lcdc.edu.in. The total fees for online form submission is Rs.1,550/- (Rs. One thousand Five Hundred and Fifty only). The payment can be made through any of the methods detailed in the instructions available on the Website. The online application form for admission can be submitted from April 23, 2018 till June 22, 2018.

Offline Submission:

The offline admission forms for B.P.Ed.-1 Classes will be available from June 04, 2018 to June 22, 2018 on a payment of Rs. 1,600/- (One Thousand Six Hundred only) on all working days from 10:00am to 02:00 pm from the College Office. The completed application forms for B.P.Ed.-1 Classes will be accepted between the dates and time mentioned above.

NOTE : The Prospectus once issued will not be taken back and no refund of any fees paid towards Prospectus or Entrance Test will be made in any circumstances.

4. Date of Entrance Test:
 - i) 25, 26, 27 June 2018 (For Boys)
 - ii) 27, 28, 29 June 2018 (For Girls)06:00 am onwards in the College Campus on all days.

Note: Written Test will be conducted on 27 June, 2018 at 2.00pm (For both Boys & Girls)

5. Result of entrance test will be put up on College Notice Boards and College Website on 30 June, 2018.

8. Reporting for Medical Test for selected & provisionally selected candidates is 04 July, 2018 at 10:00 am. Clearance in Medical examination is a MUST for admission in all categories.

Medical examination Fee: Rs. 200/- (to be paid in Cash at the time of Medical Examination)

9. Wait listed candidates should report on 7 July, 2018 at 10.00 am. The admission from the wait listed candidates will be done on the availability of seats if any and strictly on merit position basis and pass of medical examination.

11. ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:

- (a). Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50% marks and having at least participation in the Inter- College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

or

Bachelor's degree in Physical Education with 45% marks

or

Bachelor's Degree in any discipline with 50% marks and studied physical education as compulsory/ elective subject.

or

Bachelor's Degree with 45% marks and having participated in National/Inter-University/State competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in Inter- College/Inter-Zonal/District/School competition in sports and games as recognized by the AIU/IOA/SGFI/Govt. of India.

or

Bachelor's Degree with participation in international competitions or secured 1st, 2nd or 3rd position in National/Inter-University competition in sports and games as recognized by respective federations/ AIU/ IOA/ SGFI/ Govt. of India.

or

Graduation with 45% marks and at least three years of teaching experience (for deputed in service candidates i.e. trained physical education teachers/coaches).

- (b) The upper age limit is 25 years on 1 July 2018, (Born on or after 1 July, 1993) which will be relaxed for B.P.Ed.-1 course by five years only for Christian Candidates (Candidates must produce the relevant certificate from the Pastor of the Church)

Note:- Candidates who have appeared at any of the BA/BSc/BCom/or any other graduate examinations, whose result has not been declared, may apply for admission and if selected they will be given provisional admission and they will have to produce their original mark sheet along with its photocopy on or before cutoff date announced by the College. Later failing to produce original marks sheet on or before the cutoff date will lead to automatic cancellation of provisional admission.

12. Application Form must be supported by the following Documents :

- Self attested copy of the High School Certificate to verify age.
- Self attested copy of the Character Certificate from head of the institution last attended.
- Self attested copies of qualifying examination/certificates under eligibility column and certificates of competence in games and sports mentioned below under 'Sports Representation' (13d).
- Self attested copy of the blood group certificate issued by a recognized pathology Lab.
(Bring all originals at the time of Entrance Test)

13. ENTRANCE TEST:

All candidates who have applied online and offline are required to appear in B.P.Ed.-I Entrance Test at their own expense. They should bring their admit card at the time of their entrance test. This test includes written test, Skill test, Physical Fitness test and marks of Games Representation and Interview. Appropriate sports dress is a MUST for skill test and Physical Fitness Test. Civil dress is for written test and interview.

(a) Written Test: (10 Marks)

An objective type written test of one hour duration covering BA/BSc Physical Education elective subject level questions along with General Knowledge and Sports Awareness will be conducted.

(b) Skill Test: (10 Marks)

Skill test will be conducted on anyone of the games listed below (Athletics, Badminton, Basketball, Cricket, Football, Gymnastics, Handball, Hockey, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi and Volleyball). The candidate has to select one game from this list.

(c) Physical Fitness Test (42 Marks)

(Modified AAPER Test)

- 50 M Dash
- 4x10 M. Shuttle Run.
- 600 M. Run
- Sit Ups
- Chin Ups (For Boys)
- FAH (For Girls)
- Standing Broad Jump

(d) Games Representation (18 Marks)

Games representation marks will be given to only those games listed in the A.I.U. List and the representation should be within last 3 years. Games representation made before year 2014 will not be considered in this section.

- (i) International Participation: One who has represented the national team in a Recognized International competition of a particular game.
- (ii) Senior National Level: One who has represented the state teams in Senior National Championship of a particular game.
- (iii) Inter-University Level: One who has represented the University team in All India/Zonal Inter University Tournaments.
- (iv) Inter-Collegiate Level: One who has represented the college team in Inter-Collegiate competition of the respective University.

(e) Interview: (20 Marks)

The interview is to assess personality, subject knowledge, teaching potential and expression as a student-teacher.

Candidates must bring all Certificates in Original (Academics & Sports) at the time of interview.

NOTE:-Merit List will be prepared for those candidates only who will have given complete entrance test.

14. Other Important Instructions:

- a. Only Christian candidates will be allowed to avail themselves of the privilege facilities.
- b. B.P.Ed. is a professional course and the nature of the course includes a chance for injury, accident including fatal one. Therefore, students admitted

to B.P.Ed course will have to submit an affidavit on Rs.10/- stamp paper, stating that they are aware of the risk factors involved in the course and the college will not be responsible for any compensation in the event of any accident including fatal one during the course of study within or outside of the college campus.

- c. All selected candidates are required to sign a bond of rules and regulations and are required to abide by them as a precondition for admission to the B.P.Ed course. 75% attendance in all curricular and co-curricular activities of the department is a must for all candidates. Development of exemplary levels of discipline and conduct of the teacher trainees is the basic objective and requirement of this course.
- d. Graduates of Universities other than the University of Lucknow are required to submit migration certificate latest by 15 October, 2018, failing which their admission shall stand cancelled.
- e. There is no Hostel facility for Girl students. They will have to make their own arrangements for their stay outside the College premises.
- f. B.P.Ed is a professional course and requires high level of physical workouts and vigorous training. Married girl is eligible for admission. If she gets pregnant during the course including examinations, she will have to discontinue her studies. Therefore it will be compulsory for the women candidates to sign an undertaking that they will discontinue the course at once if they get pregnant during the course of study, due to the risk to life (because of rigorous training during the course). In case of hiding the fact and any casualty arising out of it the College authorities will not be responsible at all.
- g. Camping is a part of B.P.Ed curriculum and examination system. A camping fees of Rs. 5000/- will be charged and it will be spent on actual expenditure basis. The amount shall be paid by all students admitted in the academic session 2018-19 on or before 10th January 2019 through a bank draft payable at Lucknow in favour of "Principal, Lucknow Christian Degree College".
- h. Candidates are required to submit their original Blood-Group Certificate at the time of Admission.
- i. Representing any team or club in any tournament without the prior permission from the college authorities during B.P.Ed. course is a violation of college rules and strict action will be initiated against the student who violets it.
